SCHOLARSHIPS

Sponsored by District 1 Women of Steel

For 2016 there are four (4) scholarships to be awarded on a lottery basis to 2016 high school graduates:

- A. Two (2) Technical/Trade Institute Scholarships with a total value of \$1500 each to be applied toward tuition at any accredited trade or technical school in the United States.
- B. Two (2) Academic Scholarships with a total value of \$2000 each to be applied toward tuition at any accredited college or university in the United States.
- C. If in the opinion of the Committee an essay(s) rises to the level of excellence, the Committee reserves the right to award one (1) additional scholarship.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO COMPETE: Daughters and sons; step-children and legal wards (residing with or having proof of financial obligation for applicant) of any active United Steelworkers, District 1 member employed within the jurisdiction of his / her local are eligible to apply for the scholarship awards. The candidate must be in a graduating high school class during the year the scholarship is being awarded and have attained at least a 2.8 cumulative grade point average, which must be stated on the attached transcript for the year of graduation.
